General Requirements:		
	1 2	Posters should present empirical or proposed research/review:  A) Empirical research includes qualitative or quantitative primary data that was collected and analyzed as part of a study. Empirical research can be on-going.  B) Proposed research/Review includes a proposed study with a thorough literature review or a thorough literature review. IRB approval is not required at the time of presentation.  Presenting author(s) must be registered for the VSHP Fall Seminar no later than the poster presentation day. Presenting author(s) are responsible for respective meeting registration and travel expenses. Primary author for each pharmacy resident, pharmacy student, and

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		pharmacy technician poster submission will receive <b>free</b> registration for the 2023 VSHP Fall Seminar.
	3	At least 1 author must be available for discussion of their poster and a seminar badge must be worn during the poster presentation.
	4	To be eligible for award consideration the author(s) must complete submission, abstract, and poster requirements. Exclusions may apply.
	5	Primary author of the poster must be a current VSHP member.
	6	Priority for acceptance and poster display will be given to poster and abstract submissions that meet the requirements for award consideration in the poster competition.
	7	Assignment of the final poster category will be determined by the VSHP Educational Affairs Committee.
	8	Posters submitted by students, residents, and technicians will be categorized in their respective category.
	9	The VSHP Educational Affairs Committee in collaboration with VSHP reserves the right to modify requirements as needed.
